Transportation info

To/from the airport to city center:

Bybanen leaves Bergen airport every 10-15 minutes. It takes you to the city center, lasts approx. 45 minutes and costs NOK 40 by using the skyss app. Get more info on www.skyss.no

Flybussen, the airport express bus, departs every 15 minutes. The relevant stops in the city center are Festplassen and Torget, only a few minutes walk from the venue.

A one way ticket is NOK 149, paying online or with app. Paying on the bus is subject to slightly higher prices. Get more info on www.flybussen.no/bergen/

If you are 3-4 persons, consider a taxi for approx. NOK 500 from/to the airport Mon-Fri 06:00-18:00. See <http://norgestaxi.no/bergen>. A cheaper alternative is: <http://www.02365.no/>

Opening hours

The regular opening hour for shops is 10-20. Supermarkets are mostly open from 07-23. Shops and supermarkets are mostly closed on Sundays (except mini markets and kiosks).
